

TIPS TO HELP LITTLE ONES

- If needed, you can prep the piece with simple outlines in pencil for younger kids to 'colour in'
- you can outline the drawing in paint afterwards, going over your pencil lines, to make a sharper finished picture.
- Your child can write their own name, date or age on the back
- I can help finish any piece with fancy writing once back at the studio, adding a name onto the front of a mug, bowl or plate for example
